Thank you again for your attendance and participation at last December's pre-election public health forum.

As you know, PHAA WA has developed an election platform report summarising key action areas for public health in WA.

Based on this platform we will be developing an **Election Scorecard** ranking political parties according to their policies on a range of key public health issues in WA, which will be distributed to PHAA WA members and key stakeholders, accompanied by a campaign to assist them to make an informed voting choice in the 2025 State Election.

Our election platform report, ***Striving Towards a Healthier Western Australia: 2025 and beyond***, is linked [here](#) for your information; or a shorter version can be found [here](#).

As a reminder our key asks are:

1. Increase investment in prevention and health promotion for a sustainable health system.
2. Address alcohol's contribution to gender-based violence.
3. Protect children from the influence of harmful industries.
4. Raise the minimum age of criminal responsibility to 14.
5. Maintain electronic gaming machine restrictions.
6. Act boldly on climate change: set a net zero emissions by 2025 target.

We note that you addressed each of the key asks at the forum in December. If any of your responses have changed since that time, we invite you to reply with any changes **by Friday 14 February**.
